




Ex 2 Intervals of a second



Ex 3 Intervals of a third




Ex 4 Intervals of a fourth






Ex 6 Intervals of a sixth




Ex 7 Intervals of a seventh




Ex 9 Intervals of a unison




Ex 10 Intervals of a flatted second, minor second




Ex 11 Intervals of a flatted third, minor third, sharp second, augmented second




Ex 12 Intervals of a flatted fifth, tritone, diminished fifth, sharp fourth, augmented fourth
